SCHOOL FEES 2020

- The amount of school fees to be charged per learner, for the 2020 academic year shall be R 7700 per year per learner.

RESOLUTION TO CHARGE SCHOOL FEES - 2021

Pursuant to the Annual General Meeting of the parents of Randfontein Primary School, held on Tuesday 20 October 2020, the following resolution to charge school fees was passed in accordance with Section 39 of the South African Schools Act, 84 of 1996, as amended:

- a) That the amount of school fees to be charged shall be regulated and determined as follows: Annual school fees per learner shall be an amount of R7700 which shall be payable in 10 equal instalments of R770 monthly commencing in JANUARY terminating in OCTOBER.
The full amount is payable, but allowance is made to pay R 770 per month over 10 months = R 7700
R 6930 once off payment payable by the 31st of March 2021 (10% discount = R 770)
- b) That the Governing Body shall, upon application for exemption from the payment of school fees, apply the following formula in its determination of such application in accordance with the Regulations published in Govt. Gazette Nr. 29311, Vol. 496, of 18 October 2006, to provide for the equitable criteria and procedures for total, partial or conditional exemption of parents who are unable to pay school fees. [Regulations in connection with the Exemption from the payment of school fees by parents in Public Ordinary School].

THE FORMULA

$$E - 100 \left(\frac{F + A}{C} \right)$$

Where:

E	School fees as proportion of the income of a parent
F	Annual school fees, for one child, that a school charges in term of Section 39 of the Act.
A	Additional monetary contributions paid by a parent in relation to a learner's attendance of, or participation in any programme of, a public school.
C	Combined annual gross income of parents.
100	The number by which the answer arrived at in the brackets in multiplied so as to convert into a percentage.
