SCHOOL UNIFORM
GIRLS – SUMMER

- Official uniform – Tartan culottes and waistcoat. Waistcoat must be always worn with culottes.
- White short sleeved shirt.
- White ankle length socks.
- Black leather school shoes (lace up or buckle).
- Hair accessories (pony-tail scrunchies, alic band, pony-tail elastics, clips, slides) – white /navy blue/ black/ tartan matching uniform. Available at school
- Official navy-blue pullover/jersey with white stripes.
- Official navy-blue school blazer (badge for pocket available at the Nu Shop).

WINTER

- Full official tracksuit or long grey trousers.
White shirt – long sleeves.
Official navy-blue pullover / jersey.
Official navy-blue school blazer.
White socks.
Black leather school shoes.
Hair accessories – as for summer.
Official navy-blue windbreaker.

JEWELLERY

- Wristwatch.
- Earrings – 1 pair only (Plain rings or studs).

HAIR

- No dyed hair.
- Shoulder length hair must be tied back. Clip back fringes.
- Long braided hair must be tied up and no coloured braids.

GENERAL

- Medic Alert bracelet / neck chain. (Notify school of reason why the bracelet must be worn).
- Nails – To be always kept short and clean.
- **NO MAKE – UP**

FRIDAYS, SPORTS AND DAY TOURS

- Official school T-shirt.
- Official navy-blue school shorts or grey trousers or tracksuit bottom.

HATS / CAPS

- A navy-blue school cap may be worn on the playgrounds / sports field during break and sport.

BOYS - SUMMER

- White short sleeved shirt.
- Grey shorts or trousers.

- Black leather belt.

SCHOOL FEES 2024 – GRADE 1 – 7

The amount of school fees to be charged per learner, for the 2024 academic year shall be R 8600 per year per learner.

- R 8600 per year per learner. The full amount is payable, but allowance is made to pay R 860 per month over 10 months = R 8600
- R 7740 once off payment payable by the 31st of March 2024 (10% discount = R 860)

We urge parents to pay school fees promptly and to budget accordingly to alleviate any financial burden. Payment can be made in CASH, CHEQUE or DIRECT PAYMENT into the school account.
