**Earth Day**  
22 April, 2024



Earth Day is celebrated every year on 22 April. Worldwide, more than 170 countries will host rallies, outdoor events and conferences to get the green message out.

The very first Earth Day was celebrated in 1970, following the devastating 1969 oil spill in California. It was hoped that the day would inspire people to learn more about the environment and it worked brilliantly.

In 1970, Earth Day was limited to the USA, but a team of dedicated people behind it was able to inspire around 20 million people to get involved in protests, rallies and discussions.

There's not a lot of activity around Earth Day in South Africa, but that doesn't mean you can't partake. Try any of these five activities to get you in a green mood: hiking, plant a tree, start recycling, start a compost heap or garden and have a quiz night.

## SCHOOL FEES 2024 – GRADE 1 – 7

The amount of school fees to be charged per learner, for the 2024 academic year shall be R 8600 per year per learner.

- R 8600 per year per learner. The full amount is payable, but allowance is made to pay R 860 per month over 10 months = R 8600
- R 7740 once off payment payable by the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2024 (10% discount = R 860)

We urge parents to pay school fees promptly and to budget accordingly to alleviate any financial burden. Payment can be made in CASH, CHEQUE or DIRECT PAYMENT into the school account.
