PARENT UNIVERSITY

PARENT/CHILD RELATIONSHIP

- Daily Conversation About Everyday Events.**
Spend a few minutes daily with each child, talking and listening with patience and love. Take time to understand your children's world—their friends, activities, music, etc.
- Showing Affection.**
Show love to your child in many ways, from hugs to praise to special time together.
- Family Discussion of Books, Newspapers, Magazines, And TV Programs.**
Talk with your child about what he/she is reading and what you are reading.
- Family Visits to Libraries, Museums, Zoos, Etc.**
Go with your children to places where learning is a family activity. Ask school personnel or other parents for ideas of free or low-cost places your family could visit together.
- Encouragement to Try New Words.**
Make a family game out of looking up new words—who can find the newest words in the newspaper, or who can guess the correct meaning of a new word heard on TV before you look it up in a dictionary.

RAISE KIDS TO BE RESPECTFUL ADULTS

Let us teach our children how to behave at home and at school. We often forget that kids are not born with a built-in sense of respect for others.

While each child has a different personality, all children need to be respectful. People wonder why children are so disrespectful these days. We see them arguing with adults. As parents, our job is to coach kids to be able to function in the world, this means teaching them to behave respectfully towards others, not just us, their parents. The most effective way to teach kids respect is to model it ourselves. Our children may not thank us now or later, but that's okay. It's about doing the right thing.

SCHOOL FEES 2024 – GRADE 1 – 7

The amount of school fees to be charged per learner, for the 2024 academic year shall be R 8600 per year per learner.

- R 8600 per year per learner. The full amount is payable, but allowance is made to pay R 860 per month over 10 months = R 8600
- R 7740 once off payment payable by the 31st of March 2024 (10% discount = R 860)

We urge parents to pay school fees promptly and to budget accordingly to alleviate any financial burden. Payment can be made in CASH, CHEQUE or DIRECT PAYMENT into the school account.
